

## **BC Safety Authority Consultation on Proposed Fee Schedule for Alternative Safety Approaches-Safety Management Plans**

January 13, 2011

In early December 2010, we sent an e-mail providing an update on the stakeholder consultation on Alternative Safety Approaches. In that e-mail, it was mentioned that there would be a future stakeholder consultation on Alternative Safety Approaches: Safety Management Plan pricing.
